	venerate the Holy relics of St. Gerasim Boldinsky.
	Arrive in Smolensk and visit the outstanding huge
	cathedral of the Dormition of the Mother of God
	housing the impressive Holy Icon of the Smolensk
	Mother of God. Overnight in Smolensk.
21 May, Thursday	Morning visit to churches of <b>Smolensk</b> . Travel to
	Pskov-Cave Monastery (Pechory) with supper in
	Ostrov en route. Quick visit to Kazan Convent in
	Ostrov and check in to Pechory hotel.
22 May, Friday	Early morning Holy Liturgy in Pskov-Cave Monastery
